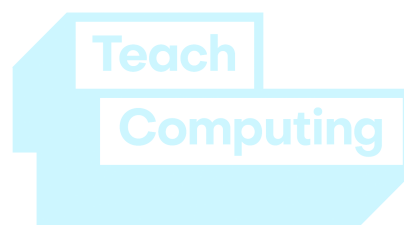

[Introduction to Primary Computing](#) - 7th December. £65 (possible subsidy of £220 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

[Teaching KS1 Computing](#) - 10th January and 24th January. £130 (possible subsidy of £440 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

[Teaching KS2 Computing](#) - 11th January and 25th January. £130 (possible subsidy of £440 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

[Getting Started in Years 1-6](#) - 11th January 2023. Six *remote* staff meetings. Free.

[Computing on a budget](#) - 7th March. £65 (possible subsidy of £220 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

[Leading Primary Computing](#) - 15th March, followed by two remote, shorter twilight sessions on 22/3/23 and 29/3/23. £130 (possible subsidy of £440 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

They include the following topics: Preparing for Ofsted; online safety; evidencing computing; using chromebooks in the classroom; audio editing; creating media; data logging; introducing micro:bits into the classroom; starting your school's Computing Quality Framework, and more.
