<u>Introduction to Primary Computing</u> - 7th December. £65 (possible subsidy of £220 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

<u>Teaching KS2 Computing</u> - 11th January and 25th January. £130 (possible subsidy of £440 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

Getting Started in Years 1-6 - 11th January 2023. Six *remote* staff meetings. Free.

<u>Computing on a budget</u> - 7th March. £65 (possible subsidy of £220 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

<u>Leading Primary Computing</u> - 15th March, followed by two remote, shorter twilight sessions on 22/3/23 and 29/3/23. £130 (possible subsidy of £440 if it were to be 1st course of the year for the school)

Further courses can be found on the <u>computing hub website</u>. Many are free to attend and can be joined remotely.

They include the following topics: Preparing for Ofsted; online safety; evidencing computing; using chromebooks in the classroom; audio editing; creating media; data logging; introducing micro:bits into the classroom; starting your school's Computing Quality Framework, and more.

The STEM Learning Centre in York is running two full day courses - <u>Developing understanding of computing in EYFS</u> - 3rd April or 21st June, 2023. Cost is £325 and the subsidy is £470 for all state schools.
