### Qualification content, structure and outcomes

This qualification provides you with an understanding of the knowledge needed when working directly with children and young people in school or college environments. It is aimed at those of you working in support roles within schools and colleges.

This qualification will equip you with knowledge, understanding and skills across a range of key subject areas, including:

- safeguarding the welfare of children and young people
- planning and preparing for learning activities
- using assessment strategies to promote learning
- promoting positive behaviour and responding to behaviour that challenges
- managing risks to health, safety and security in a work setting

To achieve this qualification you will need to complete the 11 mandatory units below:

- STL3C1: Schools and colleges as organisations
- STL3C2: Support health and safety in a learning environment
- STL3C3: Understand how to safeguard children and young people
- STL3C4: Develop professional relationships with children, young people and adults
- STL3C5: Understand how children and young people develop
- STL3C6: Support positive behaviour in children and young people
- STL3C7: Support children and young people during learning activities
- STL3C8: Support English and Maths skills
- STL3C9: Support the use of ICT in the learning environment
- STL3C10: Support assessment for learning
- STL3C11: Engage in personal and professional development

You must be at least 16 years old and be working, volunteering or be on a practical placement in a learning environment (school or college).
